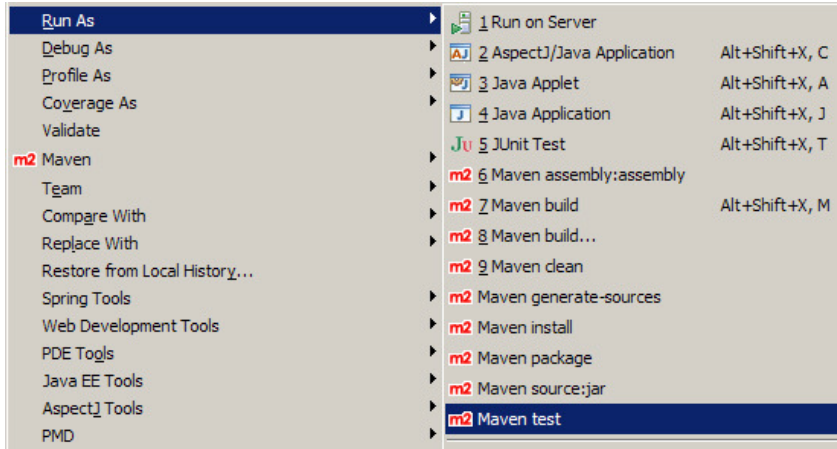


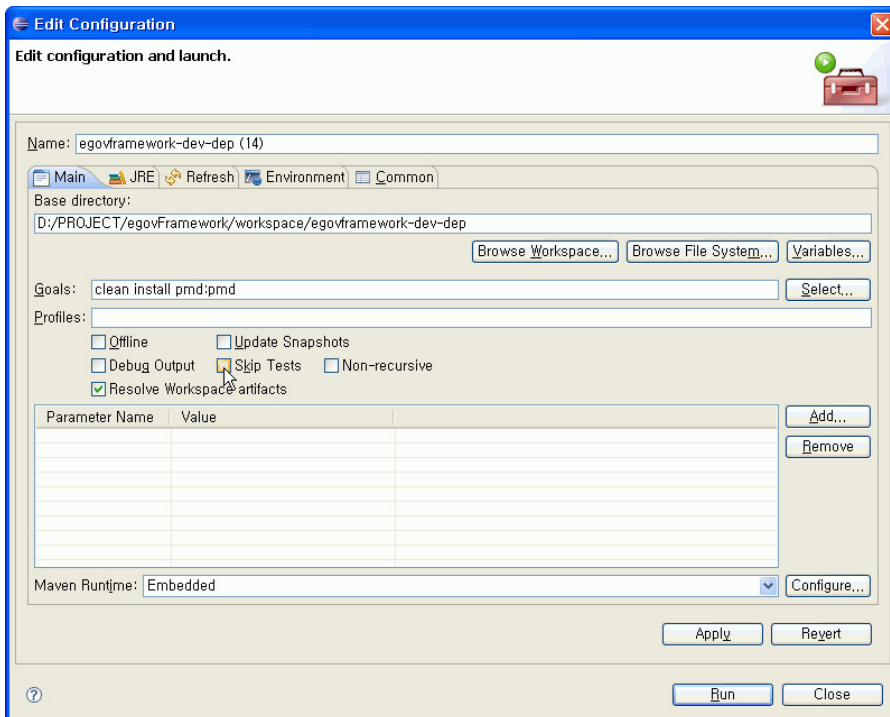
## Running Maven in Eclipse

Before you can run Maven in Eclipse, [m2eclipse](#) should be already installed. The following is how to run Maven based on m2eclipse.

- **Basic Maven goal execution** : in Context Menu, select Run As - **clean, install, package and test** are available.



- **Separate goal execution<sup>1)</sup>**
  1. In Context Menu, select **Run As > Maven build...**
  2. Input your goal in Goals
  3. Click Run



<b>Name</b>	Run As Maven name
<b>Base directory</b>	Project directory
<b>Goals</b>	Goal to execute. If multiple goals are executed, use space to separate between them.

<sup>1)</sup> Once executed in **Maven build...**, the task is saved. When you do it again, you can select **Run As > Maven build** and select from the list.
