
Running Maven in Eclipse

Before you can run Maven in Eclipse, <u>m2eclipse</u> should be already installed. The following is how to run Maven based on m2eclipse.

• Basic Maven goal execution : in Context Menu, select Run As - clean, install, package and test are available.



Separate goal execution¹

- 1. In Context Menu, select Run As > Maven build ...
- 2. Input your goal in Goals
- 3. Click Run
