

Utilization of HTML5 and CSS3.0

The e-government mobile standard framework provides a design guide for the utilization of HTML5 structure and CSS3.0.

UX Declaration

Use DOCTYPE of HTML5 to make the declaration.

For encoding, you can use simplified phrase to use a meta tag. "UTF-8" is recommended.

Structure of Mobile Page

Use the data-role="page" property of DIV tag to represent the mobile page structure.

Use header, contents and footer properties to represent the inner structure of the page.

```

  <div data-role="page">

    <div data-role="header">
      <h1>header Title</h1>
    </div>
    <!-- header end -->
    <!-- content start -->
    <div data-role="content">
```

<!-- footer start -->
<div data-role="footer">
    <h4>footer title</h4>
</div>

Utilization of CSS3.0

Using classes and external CSS files improves the consistency in documentation and the efficiency in style change than setting a style for individual pages.

CSS Grammar, and Class and ID

In order to read CSS phrases, you have to understand the selector, property and value.

```
Selector { property: value(unit); } //comments
```

It is recommended to designate classes independently. You can use multiple classes.

```
<h3 class="red">Designate red class to sub titles too.</h3>
```

ID is unique and can be used once in a document.


```
<p id="red">The ID of this paragraph is red.</p>
```

Functions of CSS3.0

Round Corner

You can create round corners, edges and buttons without using an image.

Rounded Rectangle: apply a curve to the corner by using the border-radius property value as the rate.



Gradients

You can use this to change the background color.

There are two gradients: linear and radial.

This is supported by Webkit so that CSS can use the Gradient effect.




```
background-image: -webkit-gradient(linear, left top, left bottom,
    color-stop(0, #72b0d4), color-stop(1, #4b88b6));
```

You can represent box-sizing as you want.

You cannot use this together min/max-width/height.

```
border/content-box
.box {
box-sizing: content-box;
-moz-box-sizing: content-box;
-ms-box-sizing: content-box;
-webkit-box-sizing: content-box;
}
```



Multiple transparent levels are used.

```
#trans {
opacity: 0.4;
-moz-opacity: 0.4;
-webkit-opacity: 0.4;
filter:alpha(opacity=40);
}
```

Regular image:



The same image with transparency:



You can download the web fonts.

You can add fonts easily by using the web font path.

```
@font-face {font-family: "yunache"; src: url(http://.../yunache.ttf) format("truetype");}
h1 { font-family: "yunache", sans-serif; }
```

In CSS3, shadows can be applied to the texts.

You can designate horizontal/vertical shadows, blur effect and shadow colors.

The following is how to use.

Text shadow effect!

```
h1{text-shadow: 5px 5px 5px #FF0000;}
```

You can add shadows to the boxes.

You can apply the shadow effect to the most element frames.

box-shadow: offsetX offsetY blurRadius color

offsetX : +/- pixels to X axis: to the left (-) or right (+) of the box(text)

offsetY : +/- pixels to X axis: to the left (-) or right (+) of the box(text)

blurRadius : blur level

color : color selection

The following is how to use.



```
div {
-moz-box-shadow: 10px 10px 5px #888888; /* Firefox */
-webkit-box-shadow: 10px 10px 5px #888888; /* Safari and Chrome */
box-shadow: 10px 10px 5px #888888;}
```

Use Word-Wrap property to create a new line

Phrases composed of numbers and English letters without space can be used without new lines.

Without break-word
`http://www.webdesignerwall.com_title_with_a_long_url_continue_here`

With break-word
`http://www.webdesignerwall.c
om_title_with_a_long_url_con
tinue_here`

The following is how to use.

```
.break-word {word-wrap: break-word;}
```

Extension property and browser engine per vendor

Most browser vendors created vendor extension property, assuming that the properties of their browsers can be changed or become different from the standards.

Browser /vendor-extension property/browser engine

The followings are examples.

Safari S5/ -webkit- / webkit

Chrome C8/ -webkit- / webkit

Firefox F3.6/ -moz-/ Gecko

Opera O11 / -o- / presto

Internet Explorer IE9 / -ms-, filter / Tasman
